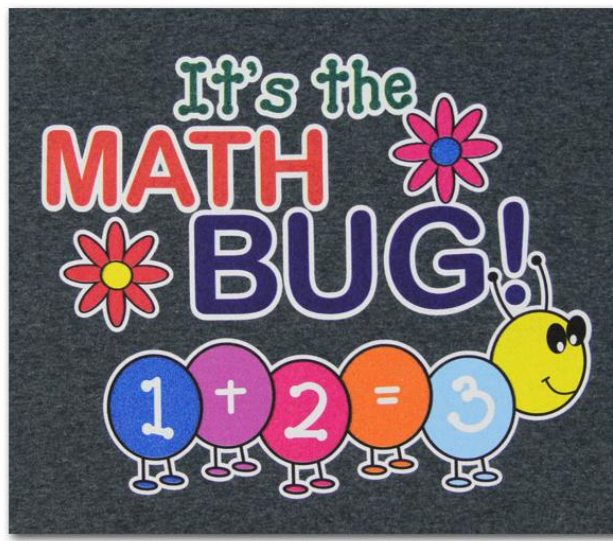

All pieces will be returned by the end of the session.

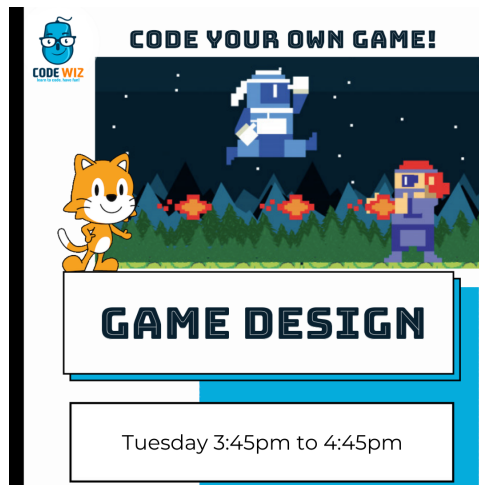
