Kindergarten Playdates Are Coming Up!




Join us on the Bancroft playground this summer to meet all the incoming Kindergarteners! We'll be getting together three times, with popsicles on site for the kids:

Let us help you cross a big item off your list this summer by having the PTO do the back-to-school shopping for you! Avoid the lines, the kids asking for all that extra stuff, and searching for hard to find items. We've got you covered.

We are selling back-to-school boxes which will include all the required supplies for each grade (*boxes do not include backpacks, lunch boxes, snack containers, and water bottles and also do not include the supplies that are marked as optional on the grade level supply lists). 


With the release of the supply lists comes the kick off of our annual Backpack Drive. It isn't live just yet, but will be shortly.

Important Reminders: CORI

Andover Public Schools require a <u>new</u> Criminal Offender Record Information (CORI) check every year for anyone who volunteers at a school or school event (i.e. field trip chaperones, volunteers for class parties, library duty, etc.). If you would like to volunteer during the 2024-2025 school year, please fill out the <u>APS CORI check form</u> and return it in person to a school administrator with an original government issued ID. Blank forms are also available at the front office. It can take 2-3 weeks for your application to process and you will not receive a notification once it's complete. You can confirm your status with the office.
